4. When the course window opens, and choose one (or more) courses in each section. Once you hit 'OK' the green check mark will appear


## **ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS**

Arrows indicate recommended transfer routes.


## **SOCIAL STUDIES**

## **MATHEMATICS**


#### Grade 11 Math Required

## **SCIENCE**

A couple notes when registering for Grade 11 Science:

- Make your best guess which Science(s) you would like to take next year.
- Sometimes taking two Sciences can help you to find your strengths and helps to keep your options open moving into Grade 12 and post-secondary.
- If you wish to take a Grade 12 Science next year (i.e. Bio 20 and Bio 30) you will need to indicate that on your Registration form and we will enter it.
- To do Chemistry or Physics you need to have a solid mark in Math 10C.
- You can go into Science 30 with a passing mark in Science 20, Chemistry 20 or Physics 20


## **SCIENCE**

## **CALM (Career & Life Management)**

#### Grade 11 CALM

CALM is a graduation requirement in Alberta. At JCS, CALM is delivered in an online environment via D2L. If you require CALM, please ensure you are choosing it from this pick list.

CALM is a mandatory course for graduation. It is delivered on-line and is worth 3 credits. You will work on it independently during one of the semesters next year.

## **OPTION COURSES**

#### **Grade 11 Options**

Students in grade 11 must take at least 7 courses throughout the year, which includes the required core courses and only one spare will be allowed. Based on student interest, option courses can complement a students timetable.
