



Common Questions

What if I plan to complete a high school course during summer school?

If you plan to complete a required course before your grade 12 year, please pre-register for the course now. When the time comes to register for summer school, make an appointment with your JCS Guidance Counsellor. Upon summer school enrollment, your summer school course will be removed from your next year's course schedule, and your Guidance Counsellor will work with you to balance the rest of your schedule.

What if I am not successful in the prerequisite course I am currently taking?

Do your best to ensure your successful completion in the courses you are currently registered in now (e.g. attend class regularly, ask for help when needed in class, complete and submit your work, and advocate for your learning needs, etc.) Register for the next level course, and if you are unsuccessful in your current course, despite all your efforts, then contact your JCS Guidance Counsellor to request an adjustment to your schedule for next year.





MATH – How do I choose?

Math 20-1 or 30-1:

- You want to go to a post-secondary program **requiring Calculus.**
- **Solid understanding of ALL outcomes in Math 10C.**

Math 20-2 or 30-2:

- You want to go to a post-secondary program **NOT requiring Calculus.**
- **Solid understanding of MOST of the outcomes in Math 10C.**

Math 20-3 or 30-3:

- You want to take a course that is more practical and hands-on.
- You want to meet the requirement for your high school diploma.
- You completed Math 10-3, or Math 20-3.




If you are interested in continuing in Mathematics at the 30-level, choose **up to two** courses.

MATH

- You need to pass Math 20-1 or 20-2 or 20-3 to graduate.
- If you are in Math 10C currently: *make your best guess, this can be changed later – don't panic!*
- If you want the AP stream choose 'AP COHORT' – this will enroll you in both Math 20-1 and Math 30-1 in grade 11.






If you are interested in continuing in the Science(s) at the 30-level, choose **up to four** courses.

Number of requests to generate : 1

SCIENCE

- You need to pass one science course at the *20 level* to graduate.
- Bio, Chem, Physics 20/30 are *rigorous and demanding* academic courses.
- If you are in Science 10 currently: *make your best guess*, this can be changed later
- If you want AP Chem, AP Physics or AP Bio please choose 'AP COHORT'
- Physics & Chemistry require a SOLID understanding of Math 10C



Grade 11 CALM

CALM is a graduation requirement in Alberta. At JCS, CALM is delivered in an online environment via D2L. If you require CALM, please ensure you are choosing it from this pick list.

Career & Life Management (CALM)

- CALM is *required for graduation*.
- At JCS we offer CALM online - through D2L.
- It is worth 3 credits.
- You will not have a CALM class to attend, you must work on this independently.
- Every Grade 10 student will be enrolled in CALM for Grade 11.
- Let your Student Advisor know if you have already completed it before the course begins.



Grade 12 Option Courses

Choose up to 3 Option Courses. Course selections should be based on meeting graduation requirements, interests, and potential post-high school plans. Note that you will need to meet any prerequisites for any courses chosen.

OPTION COURSES



- You need a ***minimum of 10 credits (not classes)*** in: CTS, Fine Arts, PE 20/30, Approved LDC courses, or Work Experience to graduate
- It is a good idea to have an option course that you can take until the 30 level.
- Option courses at the 30 level can be used in post-secondary applications
(*check specific requirements, all programs are different*).
- Option courses at the 30 level can also be used to meet your 30 level requirements besides ELA or Social.



A few reminders...

- The courses entered in PowerSchool ***are requests only***. These are *not the confirmed courses* that you will receive next year.
- You're not guaranteed a class because you entered your information in first.
- Students will be given an opportunity to make changes to their initial requests in April.
 - For example, changing Math 30-1 to 30-2 or choosing Biology 20 instead of Chemistry 20
- Please have this completed **by March 16, 2026**.
 - If you do not choose courses by this date, courses may be chosen for you by your Student Advisor
