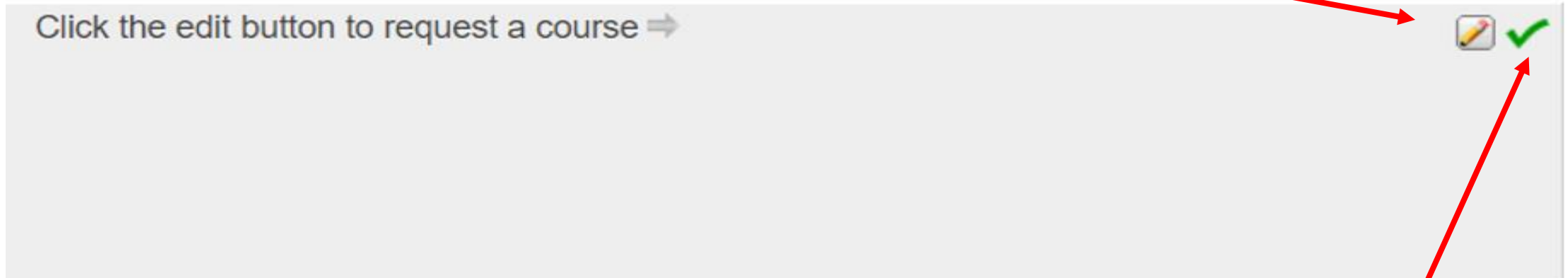

COURSE REQUESTS

1. Log into your PowerSchool account
2. On the left hand side of the screen, click the “Class Registration” link
3. Click on each core course (the pencil)



4. When the course window opens, choose one (or more) courses in each section. Once you hit ‘OK’ the green check mark will appear

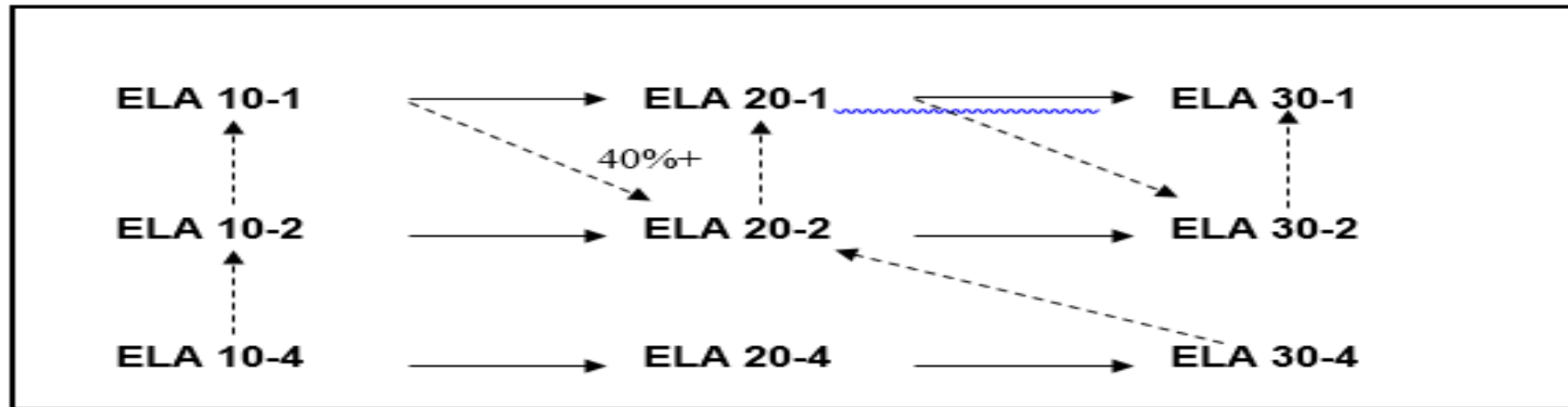
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Arrows indicate recommended transfer routes.

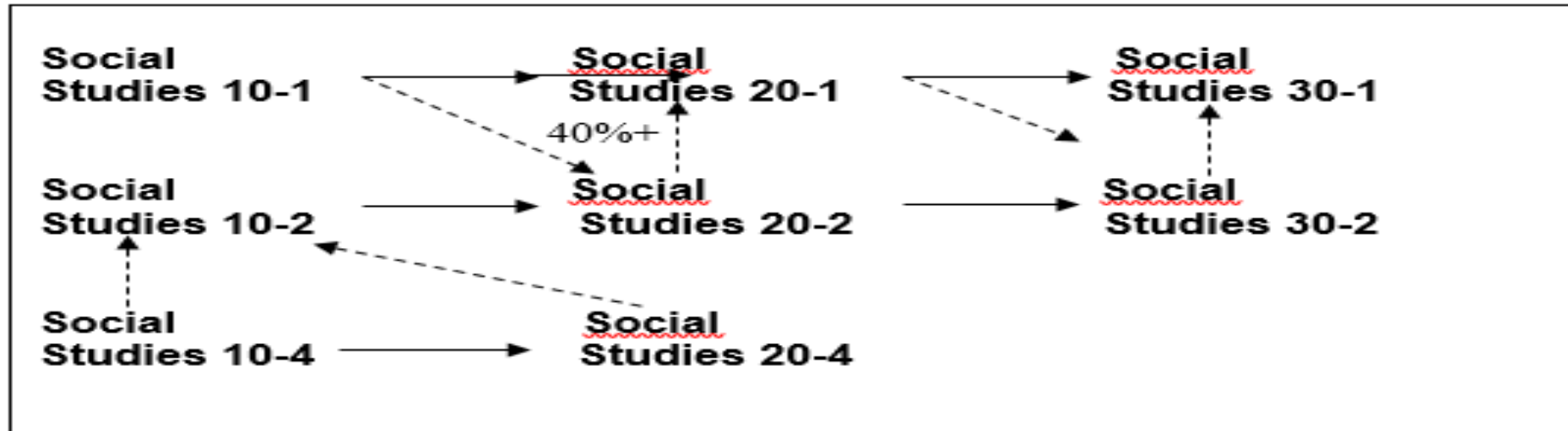
SOCIAL STUDIES

Arrows indicate recommended transfer routes.

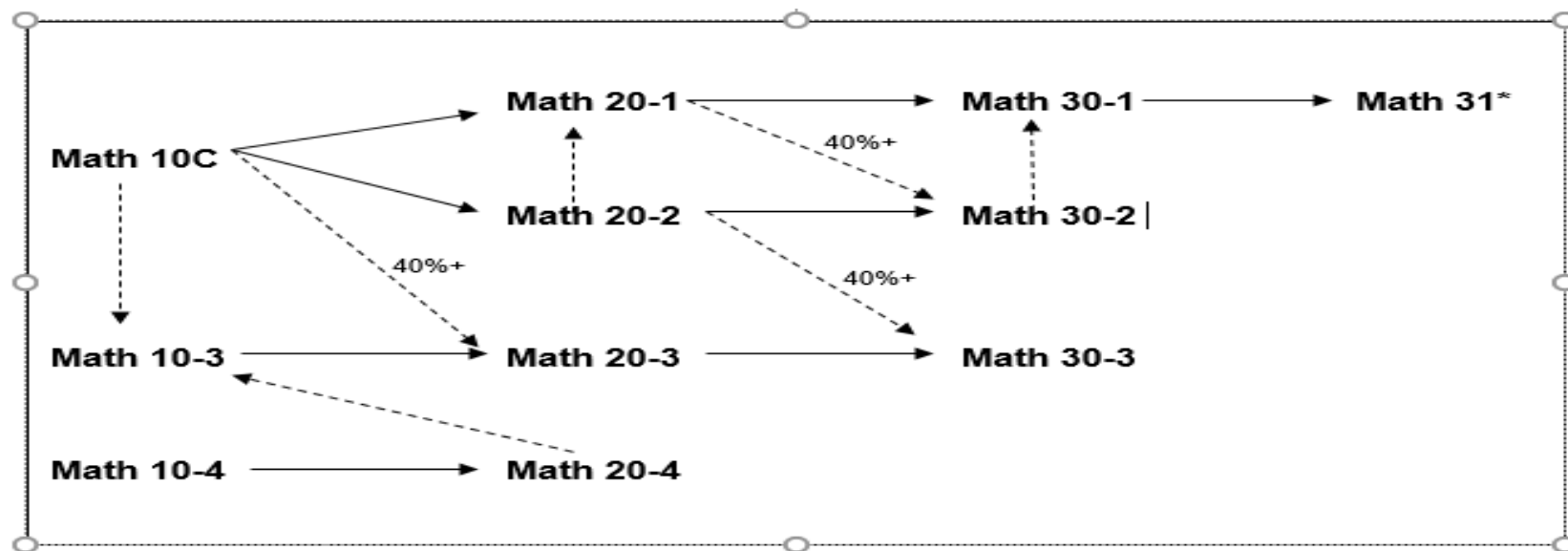
MATHEMATICS

When choosing a Math course at the 30 level, please make sure you have the applicable prerequisite course. In Math 30-1 and 30-2, you write a provincial Diploma Exam worth 30% of your final grade.



Arrows indicate recommended transfer routes.

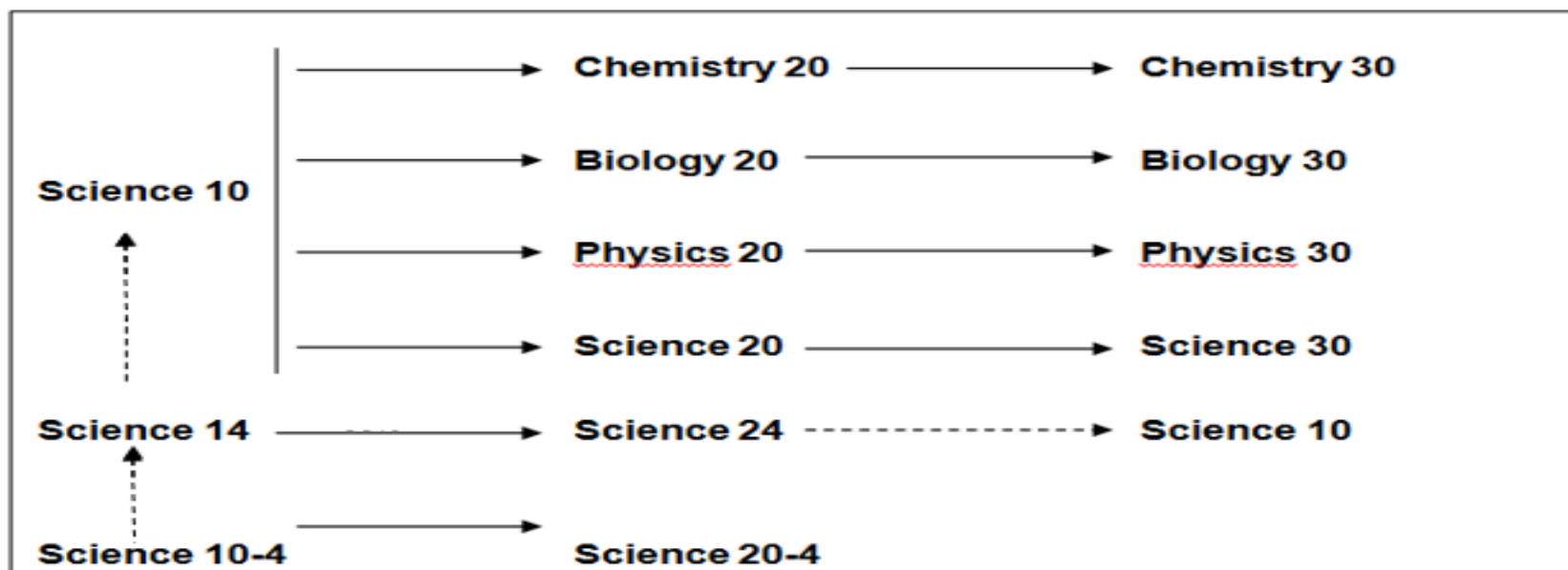
SCIENCE

Grade 12 Science

When choosing a Science course at the 30 level, please be sure you have the prerequisite course. In Bio 30, Chem 30, Physics 30 and Science 30, you write a provincial Diploma Exam worth 30% of your final grade.



OPTION COURSES

Grade 12 Options

Click the edit button to request a course ➡



Students in grade 12 must take at least 6 courses, which includes required core courses (ELA and Social Studies). Based on student interest, option courses can complement a student timetable. You may use 10 credits from 30 level complementary courses to meet Diploma requirements.

It's a good idea to choose some option courses so that your schedule reflects balance in your Grade 12 year (not all core classes). You are entitled to two spares if you will have a minimum of **75** credits by the end of Grade 11.

ALTERNATE OPTION COURSES

Please choose two options courses that are different than the ones selected above just in case we are unable to fulfill your first choices.

You should choose a couple alternate option courses, just in case we are unable to get some of the courses you requested. You must be in a minimum of **6** classes (1 spare per semester).

CALM (Career & Life Management)

CALM

Click the edit button to request a course ➡



CALM is a graduation requirement in Alberta. At JCS, CALM is delivered in an online environment via D2L. If you require CALM, please ensure you are choosing it from this pick list.

This is a mandatory course for graduation. If you did not complete it last year, it must be done during your Grade 12 year. It is delivered on-line and is worth 3 credits. You will work on it independently during one of the semesters next year.

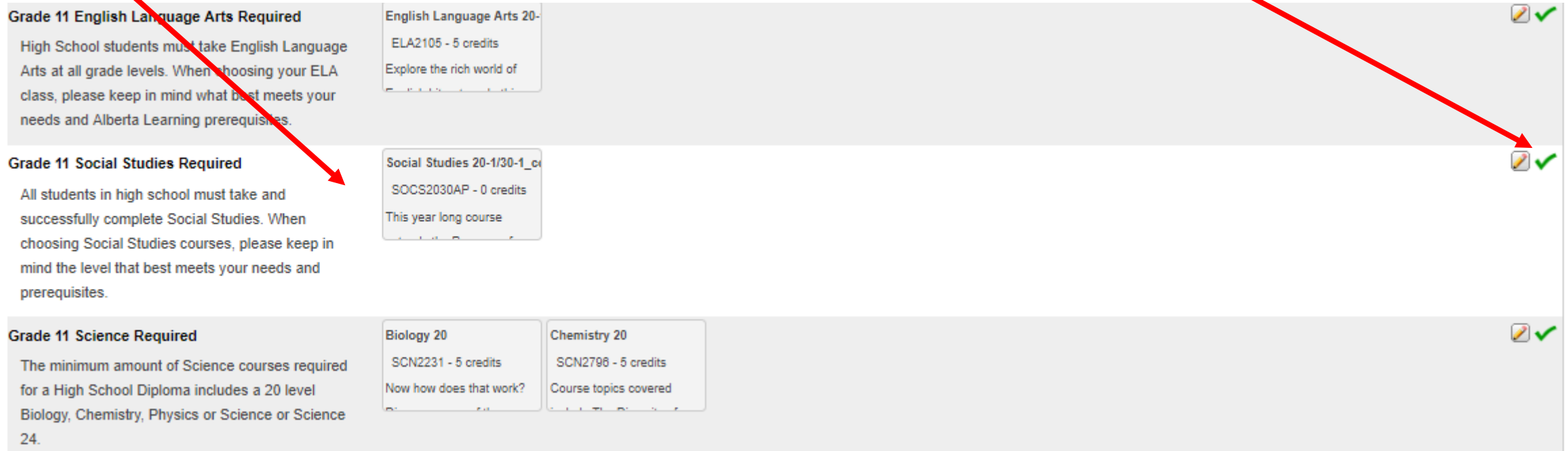
